National Surgeons Week, from June 9<sup>th</sup> to 15<sup>th</sup>, with Surgeon's Day on 15<sup>th</sup> June, was an initiative by ASI President, from 2025.

Mumbai Surgical Society actively participated by holding various programs in different parts of the City.

A report:

**National Surgeons Week: June 9<sup>th</sup>-15<sup>th</sup> and Surgeon's Day: June 15<sup>th</sup>** was celebrated by Mumbai Surgical Society, City Chapter of ASI, by conducting several social programs, in different areas and Hospitals of Mumbai and beyond.

We present to you a brief report of activities, chronologically, with relevant pictures.

### 1) 11<sup>th</sup> June: Awareness of Sexual Violence: Medico-Legal Aspect & Medical & Surgical Care.

Social Awareness program organized at the Khan Bahadur Kurla Bhabha Hospital, along with Dilaasa, CEHAT and Hari Namu Foundation.

Sexual violence is a serious public health and human rights issue that requires a holistic and



coordinated response. To address this pressing concern, an Awareness Camp and Training session was organized.

**2) 12<sup>th</sup> June: Free social awareness and medical camp**  
Free Social Awareness and Medical Camp for Diabetic Foot and Lifestyle Diseases. On 12th June 2025, Dr. Ruke's Advance Diabetic Foot & Wound Management Clinic, in collaboration with the **Mumbai Surgical Society** and Hari Namu Foundation, organized a **Free Social Awareness and Medical Camp**.

The event was held at Business Point Building, Chembur, Mumbai, and aimed at promoting early detection and prevention of diabetes-related complications.

Special attention was given to diabetic foot care with the use of advanced tools like the podocan and bioesthesiometry.

This initiative was crucial in spreading awareness about the importance of regular health checkups, especially for those with chronic conditions like diabetes. It also empowered patients with knowledge on preventing serious complications such as foot ulcers and amputations.

Such camps reflect the importance of community health outreach in creating a healthier, more informed society.





The camp provided a range of free services to all patients, including blood sugar estimation, HbA1c testing, liver function tests, lipid profiles, foot examinations, and bone mineral density tests.
